

Olga Bocharova Ph.D., Dr. Sci., Professor

Laureate of the USSR State Committee for Inventions and Discoveries, Laureate of the award of the Foundation for the Promotion of Domestic Medicine, Doctor of Biological Sciences, Professor, Head of the Laboratory for Immunopharmacology, Research Institute of Experimental Therapy and Diagnostics of Tumor, FSBI "N.N. Blokhin National Medical Research Center of Oncology", Ministry of Health of Russia.

O. A. Bocharova is one of the leading experts in the field of adhesive dysregulation of tumor growth, development of immunobiological approaches to non-toxic prevention and therapy of malignant neoplasms, as well as diseases of aging. The concept developed by O. A. Bocharova about the key role of adhesion disorders in neoplasia (in the target tissue and in the processes of immunoreactivity), as well as about central neuronal (with the participation of dopaminergic neurons) adhesion-damaging factors that reveal the stress mechanism of cancer etiology, has become known not only in our country, but also abroad. The logical development of O. A. Bocharova's theoretical propositions is their practical, clinical orientation, which led to the development of complex phytoadaptogens preparations with, among other things, adhesive and neuroprotective effects, which makes a significant contribution to the development of pathogenetic therapy and prevention of malignant neoplasms.

Her research interests relate to the fundamental problems of adhesive interactions, including in the reactions of immunity against tumors, which is reflected in printed works and public speeches.

Olga A. Bocharova is the author of over 300 scientific papers published in major national and international journals, she has 1 discovery, 9 patents for inventions and 4 monographs. Olga A. Bocharova has been a supervisor for 7 PhD theses. The Hirsch index 21.
